Dear Parent/Carer

As you would be aware, our K-2 Skiing Program will take place on **Friday 3 August and Friday 10 August at Thredboland.**

Points to remember:

- You will need to arrange your child's ski equipment prior to the ski day. Costs do not include equipment. Students need to come to school equipped for snowsports.
- Label everything with your child's name. Label hire clothing and equipment (masking tape works, but remember to remove the tape before returning your equipment). If the children have their own equipment, make sure it is also clearly labelled.
- Children need to practise doing up their own boots, clipping in and out of their skis and sliding skis together for easy carrying.
- Children are to bring their own morning tea. Lunch is provided by Thredboland.
- ***Please ensure that your child arrives at school dressed in their ski gear by 8.00 am.*** The buses leave at 8.20 am and we cannot wait for latecomers. The bus will pick up and drop off children in Berridale at the Arlberg Ski Shop and Jindabyne at the Old Shopping Centre, if indicated on the previous permission note.
- If your child is unable to attend on a particular ski day, please phone prior to 8.00 am on the school mobile 0467 151 463.
- ***Children will be dismissed*** upon our return at approximately 4.50 pm. ***For safety reasons, all the gear needs to be unloaded from the buses before the children are dismissed.*** We also ask for your assistance in helping to unload buses and placing equipment onto the path area for collection.
- Please do not park in the crossing area of Murray Street when you arrive to collect your child.
- **An additional form from Thredbo is attached and required to be completed and returned to school by Monday, July 30.** Your child will not be able to participate if this form is not returned.

Please read the attached outline and ensure the checklist is completed and sent in with your child on each ski day. Further information will be distributed shortly to parents who have indicated that they can assist on the ski days. Thank you for your assistance.

OUTLINE OF THE DAY- ALL TIMES ARE APPROXIMATE ONLY

8.00 am	Load buses, take roll
8.20 am	Depart
8.50 am	Pick up at Berridale Arlberg Ski Shop
9.15 am	Pick up at Jindabyne Old Shopping Centre
9.55 am	Arrive at Thredbo – unload bus, put on ski boots/ gear, have morning tea, walk to Thredboland area with designated teacher and/or parent and meet instructors.
10.30am	2 hour lesson
12.30 pm	Lunch at Thredboland
1.00 pm	2 hour lesson
3.00 pm	Return to bus, Pack bus
3.30 pm	Take roll, depart
4.00 pm	Drop off at Jindabyne Old Shopping Centre
4.25 pm	Drop off at Berridale Arlberg Ski Shop
4.45- 5.00 pm	Arrive in Cooma, dismiss students from inside playground

EQUIPMENT STUDENTS NEED TO HAVE

Eye Protection	Goggles or sunglasses. Please note: Sunglasses are not very effective when it is snowing heavily.
Gloves	Good quality <u>ski</u> gloves – a spare pair is often a good idea
Ski jacket and ski pants	labelled.
Beanie/hat	labelled.
Sunscreen	This should be applied at the start of the day.
Helmet	A snowsport approved helmet must be worn at all times on the slopes.
Clothes	A dry change of clothes (including socks, underwear) should be packed in a separate plastic bag.
Skis, boots, poles	If your child is a beginner, they will not require poles
Ski boots	Please make sure they fit as comfortably as possible, that they are not broken and that there is a left and right foot.
Ski Checklist	Each day your child must have the Snowsport Checklist filled in and shown to a teacher before they get on the bus. Please remove this form from this information pack and complete it each day.
All labelled equipment	Placed in a labelled bag/s (except skis and poles)

If you are hiring equipment from local proprietors, please mention that you are from St Patrick's to receive a local price.
