Secondary Snowsports Program Term 3 2017

Thank you for your interest in St Patrick's Secondary Snowsports program. The purpose of this letter is to give you details of the 2017 program and request that fees and the attached permission notes are returned to the office by Wednesday 26 July (Week 2 Term 3).

The primary and secondary programs will run on the same days at the same time, however secondary students will be in high school lessons, unless numbers of students with similar skill levels are too small. If this occurs students of similar skill level will be combined together.

Normal lessons will continue at school on each of the days of the Snowsports program for Secondary students. An alternate program will run for those students still at school in Primary. Secondary students participating in the Snowsports program are expected to catch up missed work in their own time.

PROGRAM DETAILS (SECONDARY)

Equipment required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All students must wear a helmet (unless participating in XC skiing), carry sunscreen, have goggles and suitable clothing for Snowsports Hire of equipment is not included in costs and is the responsibility of each student Snowboarders must wear wrist guards It is recommended that if students have a mobile phone that they bring it Secondary students can purchase lunch at various eateries on the mountain if they wish.
Outline of time on snow at Perisher	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 10:00am Arrive at Smiggins and lift/lesson tickets distributed ➤ 10:30am All students start their 4 hour lesson ➤ 12:30pm Students will be given a 30 minute lunch break by their instructor. Secondary students will have lunch at various venues around Perisher with their instructors. XC skiers will have lunch at the Perisher Nordic Shelter. ➤ 1:00-3:00pm Students will continue in their lesson ➤ 3:20pm Back at Bus ➤ 3:30pm Students on bus ready to depart
Safety	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any unsafe behaviour of student can result in them not being allowed to ski/board. This will be a decision made by the teachers. All students will carry a contact card. This will have their name, school, school mobile number and ski patrol number Students and parents must have read the Alpine Responsibility Code attached You must indicate your child's skiing/boarding ability on the attached form. Skiing and Boarding ability will ultimately be determined by the Smiggins Instructors. Due to DET and Catholic Education guidelines this year Perisher is only offering 4 hour lessons. Local schools are getting these at a very good price and should allow students to progress their skiing or boarding. Free skiing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will only apply to Secondary students Will be limited Can ONLY be done at Smiggins. Students must ski/board in a group, never on their own. Someone in this group must have a mobile phone Parents can request that their child is closely supervised by a teacher during free skiing
Emergency	<p>If there is an accident the student or those in their group</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Contacts the school mobile and waits for instructions If serious enough, alert ski patrol A teacher will immediately be despatched to the accident site Students can be taken to the Perisher Medical centre. Parents must be prepared to pay for all costs incurred at the Medical Centre.
Medical information	<p>It is the responsibility of the parent to make sure the school office has the most up to date medical information for each child.</p> <p>This medical information will be taken to Perisher Valley each day and kept by the teacher in charge.</p>

Expectations:

Snowsports is a privilege and requires students to be sensible, act safely and demonstrate a sense of belonging to the school. It is expected that all assessment tasks are up to date to a satisfactory standard.

If a student cannot demonstrate these qualities at school, they could be excluded from participating in Snowsports. This decision will be made by school staff in consultation with Mr Lawley, Mr Introna and Mr Joyce.

Cancellations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If your child is ill or does not attend a Snowsport day which you have paid for, a refund of their lift and lesson will be arranged. Students will still be expected to pay the cost for the bus regardless of attendance, once they have committed to the program. If a student gives enough warning that they cannot attend we may be able to replace them on the bus. However, there is no guarantee this can happen. It will be case by case arrangement.
