School Uniform

The school uniform is an important part of school life at St Patrick's. School spirit, pride in the school and a strong sense of belonging are encouraged by the wearing of the school uniform. When full uniform cannot be worn a parent's note explaining the situation must be carried by the student at all times.

The following points must be noted in relation to uniform:

- The uniform should always be neat, clean and tidy.
- The only jewellery permitted is a signet ring, watch, and one sleeper or stud earring worn in each ear. Bracelets, facial piercings and chunky jewellery pose a WH&S risk and, therefore, are not to be worn.
- No make-up or nail polish is to be visible.
- Hair is to be neatly presented, away from the face. Any hair ties or head bands are to be functional, rather than decorative, and to be school colours. Extremes of cut or colour are not permitted.
- Boys' facial hair is to be clean shaven.
- Girls' dresses and skirts are to be *below* knee length.
- Ties are expected to be worn up to and covering the top button of the shirt.
- Belts should be black or dark brown.
- Non-uniform garments (eg coloured T-shirts, singlets, boxer shorts or leggings) are not to be visible.
- Some Key Learning Areas (subjects) have special requirements concerning dress, eg aprons or uniforms for TAS; long hair tied back for PDHPE, Science, Design and Technology and Visual Arts. These regulations **must** be followed.

No skate, canvas or ballet shoes permitted. ▪ Black riding boots are permitted in K-6 only 	<p>Sports/PE Uniform</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plain green microfibre shorts ▪ Gold sports shirt with short or long sleeves, collar and school crest ▪ Plain white sport socks with no other colour markings ▪ Sports shoes -no skate, canvas or casual wear shoes permitted as these do not comply with WHS ▪ School green tracksuit with school crest -the complete school tracksuit must be worn, ie school jumpers are not to be worn in place of the tracksuit top ▪ A plain white skivvy may be worn under the gold sports top in winter <hr/> <p>General: White shirts are being phased in for K-6, but fawn shirts may be worn in the interim.</p>
<p>Hats</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The school hat or cap must be worn for all sport and outdoor activities. Students will not be allowed to play in unshaded spaces at recess or lunch time if their hats are not worn in Term 1 and Term 4. All students will all have a broad- brimmed or bucket style bottle green hat as caps will be phased out. 	
<p>Jumpers/Jackets</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students permitted to wear a green knitted school jumper K-10 or 'sloppy joe' K-6 only with the school crest

<p>K-6 Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Green gored skirt, length: <i>below</i> the knee ▪ Green tights ▪ Straight cut green gabardine trousers (cord and jeans fabrics are not permitted) Length must be below the ankle ▪ A white skivvy may be worn in winter with or without the shirt and tie - K-2 only ▪ White blouse with green with gold stripe school tie ▪ Black scarves, beanies and fingerless gloves without obvious brands/logos 	<p>K-6 Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plain grey long pants - approved designs (cargo pants are not permitted) ▪ Long sleeve white shirt ▪ Green with gold stripe school tie ▪ A white skivvy may be worn in winter with or without the shirt and tie - K-2 only ▪ Black scarves, beanies and fingerless gloves without obvious brands/logos
<p>7-10 Summer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Checked dropped waist dress with button up front and pleated skirt, length: <i>below</i> the knee ▪ Plain white ankle socks 	<p>7-10 Summer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plain grey shorts – approved designs: cargo shorts and $\frac{3}{4}$ pants are not permitted ▪ Plain white shirt, short sleeve ▪ Plain white or grey ankle socks
<p>7-10 Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Tartan skirt with two inverted pleats with elasticised sides and back zipper, length: <i>below</i> the knee ▪ Plain green gabardine tailored trousers ▪ White long or short sleeved blouse, no tie is required but top button to be done up for all official school functions ▪ Black tights ▪ Green knitted school jumper with embroidered school crest ▪ Black scarves, beanies and fingerless gloves without obvious brands/logos 	<p>7-10 Winter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Plain grey long pants – approved designs (cargo pants are not permitted) ▪ Plain white or grey socks ▪ Long sleeve white shirt with a button-up collar ▪ Green with gold stripe school tie ▪ Green knitted school jumper with embroidered crest ▪ Black scarves, beanies and fingerless gloves without obvious brands/logos
